Tournament conditions

CAPACITY

This tournament has a maximum capacity of **120 players**. A **minimum of 70 participants** will be required to hold the tournament. If the minimum number of players is not met, **Grand Hyatt La Manga Club** will be obliged to cancel the event with a refund of the deposit.

PARTICIPANTS Only players in possession of a licence and handicap may participate. *Foreign players must certify their handicap through their corresponding federation.*

- Gentlemen: yellow tees
- Ladies: red tees
- Junior (13 to 14 years) and Cadets (15 to 16 years):
 - Boys: yellow tees
 - Girls: red tees
- Alevines (11 to 12 years old):
 - Boys: blue tees
 - Girls: red tees
- Benjamins (age limit 9 to 10 years): red tees

HANDICAPS CATEGORIES:

Gentlemen: There will be two categories made at 50% of entries with the playing HCP is limited to 26.4.

Ladies: playing HCP is limited to 36.

Benjamins and alevines categories : playing HCP is limited to 54.

Junior and cadets categories: playing HCP is limited to 36.

FORMAT

Individual Stableford over 36 holes.

Family Tournament: This will run parallel to the main tournament, with a special prize for the three best family results.

FAMILY TOURNAMENT RULES

Each family unit will be assigned a team name for scoring purposes. The final team score will be calculated using the two best results from the team, consisting of one adult and one junior. If there are more than two players within the family/team, the two best individual scores between one adult and one junior will be selected.

This combined score will determine 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in the family category.

Scoring will be managed by the Real Golf La Manga Club Competition Committee. Each group will use only one virtual scorecard.

All scores will be valid for handicap adjustment with the Royal Spanish Golf Federation (Real Federación Española de Golf).

Please note: Handicaps will not be updated after the first round—participants will play both tournament days with the same handicap.

TIEBREAKS

In the event of a tie in the general classification we will be governed by the official criteria of the *Royal Spanish Golf Federation*.

COMPETITION CLAIMS

Complaints must be submitted in writing to the competition **committee before 12:00 p.m.** the following morning of the competition.

The Competition Committee reserves the right to modify the tournament conditions.

Live Scoring System - **GOLFDIRECTO APP**

The scoring system used during the tournament will be Golf Directo, so that the results may be entered during the round and updated automatically. This way players will be able to follow the evolution of the tournament .

On Thursday 14th of August, you will receive your virtual scorecard by email, which you will be able to open one hour before your tee time. It is not essential to download the app, although it is recommended. You will receive your card by email and will be able to enter your results regardless of whether you have downloaded the app.

The results will be validated easily by player and scoreboard, and verified by the competition committee.

It is essential that at least one player in each match updates all 4 players results every hole, which must be verified by each player and marker before the end of the round. The end of the round will mean the signature of the card and conformity with the result entered. The result per hole must be the total number of strokes of each player (gross result), the system will calculate the net results or Stableford according to the handicap of each player.

NORTH COURSE

Local rules north course

In addition to the Rules of Golf and the Permanent Local Rules of the RFEG, the following local rules shall apply.

OUT OF LIMITS (Rule 18.2)

- Defined by stakes and/or white lines, fences, fences and/or walls. When defined by walls, the LF is determined by the closest point to the field at ground level. If there are
- Stakes and white lines to mark the LF, the stakes identify the LF and the lines define the LF.

ANORMAL COURT CONDITIONS (Rule 16.1)

- **Land under repair:** All areas enclosed with stakes or blue lines and/or white lines.
- **Immovable Obstructions:**
 - 1.All roads asphalted/concreted.
 - 2.Stone and/or wooden walls surrounding trees.
- **Integrating Objects**
 - 1.All non-asphalted or non-concreted paths, including those covered with gravel.
 - 2.Landscaped areas, including those covered with gravel and/or pine bark.
 - 3.Natural flowerbeds.

If there are white stakes along the buggy paths, they identify the out-of-bounds, the out-of-bounds being determined by the nearest edge of the buggy paths. the out-of-bounds, the out-of-bounds being determined by the edge closest to the stake of the buggy path. to the stake of the buggy path.

NORTH COURSE

PREFERRED LIE (BALL PLACEMENT) RLM E-3

- When a player's ball comes to rest in the General Area on mown grass at fairway height or below, the player may relieve himself once by placing the original ball or another ball in this relief area: Reference Point: The resting point of the original ball. Size of the
- relief area measured from the reference point: the length of a scorecard (approx. 15
- cm). Limitations on the location of the Relief Area: Must be no closer to the hole than the reference point.
- Must be in the General Area

WASTE AREAS

The sand area to the left of the fairway on the 17th hole of the North Course is part of the general area, not a bunker.

DROPPING ZONES

HOLE 17A EXCLUSIVELY for RELIEF for WRONG GREEN and BUNKERS (HOYO 17B)

There is a ZD when playing hole 17A. This ZD - situated to the right of the fairway - may be used as an additional option when taking relief **ONLY** for the wrong green as provided for in Rule 13.1f and for the bunkers adjacent to this green. This green and adjacent bunkers are situated to the right of the fairway of the 17th hole.

NORTH COURSE

Penalties

Procedure in the Event of Suspension of Play (Rule 5.7b)

When the Committee has suspended play because of a dangerous situation, if players in a party or group are between holes, they shall not resume play until ordered to do so by the Committee. If they are playing a hole, they shall stop play immediately and shall not resume play until ordered to do so by the Committee. If a player does not stop play immediately he shall be disqualified unless there are circumstances justifying suspension of the penalty in accordance with Rule 5.7b. The signal for suspension of play and resumption of play shall be as follows:

- **Interrupt the Game immediately: One prolonged sound of the siren.**
- **Interrupt Play: Three consecutive short blasts of the siren.**
- **Resume Play: Two consecutive short blasts of the siren.**

Please keep buggies on the fairways or in the rough on par 3's and on the fairways around the tees and greens. Where possible, do not drive buggies between the green and green bunkers. Repeated infringements could result in disciplinary action by the club or disqualification from a competition.

NORTH COURSE

North Course evacuation plan

In the event of an evacuation of the pitch, players must go to the nearest of the points marked on the plan for their transfer. They shall also await their return to these points.



CONCENTRATION POINTS:

1.- Holes tee 1 and 10, green 9 and 15, fairways 16, 17 and 18: Clubhouse. 2.- Holes 2, 8, green 7, tee 9 and green 10, 14: Tunnel on the way to hole 2. 3.- Holes 3, 4, tee 5, green 6, tee 12, 7 and green 11: 12th tee walkways 4.- Holes 13, tee 14, green 6, tee 6, green 5: Maintenance Area

SOUTH COURSE

Local rules south course

In addition to the Rules of Golf and the Permanent Local Rules of the RFEG, the following local rules shall apply.

OUT OF LIMITS (Rule 18.2)

- Defined by white stakes and/or lines, fences, railings and/or walls. When defined by walls, the out of bounds is determined by the point closest to the course at ground level.
- If both white stakes and lines are used to mark the out of bounds, the stakes identify it and the lines define it.

ANORMAL COURT CONDITIONS (Rule 16.1)

GROUND UNDER REPAIR

- All areas enclosed with blue stakes or lines and/or white lines.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

- All roads asphalted/concreted. Stone and/or
- wooden walls surrounding trees.

CONSTITUENT OBJECTS

- All non-asphalted or non-concreted paths, including those covered with gravel. Landscaped areas, including those covered with gravel and/or pine bark.
- Natural flowerbeds.

If there are white stakes next to buggy paths, these identify the out-of-bounds, the out-of-bounds being determined by the nearest edge of the buggy path. The out-of-bounds is determined by the edge closest to the stake of the buggy path.

SOUTH COURSE

PREFERRED LIE (BALL PLACEMENT) RLM E-3

When a player's ball lies in the General Area on closely mown grass at fairway height or lower, the player may take relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in this relief area:

- Reference point: the spot where the original ball came to rest.
- Size of the relief area measured from the reference point: the length of a scorecard (approx. 15 cm)
- Relief Area Location Restrictions:
 - Must not be closer to the hole than the reference point
 - Must be in the General Area

• DROP ZONES HOLES 11 AND 12 (FOR PENALTY AREAS)

There are DZs located to the left of both penalty areas, where as an additional option to those provided by Rule 17, the player may drop a ball with one penalty stroke when their ball comes to rest in either of these penalty areas.

WASTE AREAS

The sand area located to the right of the fairway on hole 14 of the South Course is part of the general area; it is not a bunker.

Penalties

Penalty for infringement of these Local Rules: General Penalty

Procedure in the event of Suspension of Play (Rule 5.7b) When the Committee has suspended play because of a dangerous situation, if players in a match or group are between holes they shall not resume play until ordered to do so by the Committee. If they are playing a hole, they shall stop play immediately and shall not resume play until ordered to do so by the Committee. If a player does not stop play immediately he shall be disqualified unless there are circumstances that justify suspension of the penalty in accordance with Rule 5.7b.

The signal for suspension of play and resumption of play shall be as follows:

- **Interrupt the Game immediately: One prolonged sound of the siren.**
- **Interrupt Play: Three consecutive short blasts of the siren. Resume Play:**
- **Two consecutive short blasts of the siren.**

Please keep buggies on the fairways or in the rough on par 3's and on the fairways around the tees and greens. Where possible, do not drive buggies between the green and green bunkers. Repeated infringements could result in disciplinary action by the club or disqualification from a competition.

SOUTH COURSE

South Course evacuation plan

In the event of an evacuation of the pitch, players must go to the nearest of the points marked on the plan for their transfer. They shall also await their return to these points.



CONCENTRATION POINTS:

- 1.1.- Holes 4, 5, green 3: 5th tee toilets
- 2.2.- Holes 1, 2, 6, green 9, tee 3, tee 7, green 18: halfway house
- 3.3.- Holes 8, 14, tee 9, tee 15: 15th tee toilets
- 4.4.- Holes 10, 11, 12, 13, green 15, green 7, hole 18: 10th tee toilets
